



## Art and Craft Workshops

### 1. Carving wooden spoons with Keith Ferry

Saturday March 21<sup>st</sup> 10am – 4pm

Using wood from local sycamore, Keith will guide and teach a maximum of 8 adults how to carve a wooden spoon

Cost: £20 per person

### 2. Easter clay pot workshops with Claude Frere- Smith

Saturday April 11<sup>th</sup>

Collect flowers, grass etc to decorate your clay pot.

1<sup>st</sup> session 10 am-11.30am

2<sup>nd</sup> session 1pm- 2.30pm

Claude will show 3 basic clay building techniques with air drying clay using inspiration from the woods

Maximum of 15 per session, adults and children. All children must be with participating adult

Create a card using lino cut. Susan will guide a maximum of 10 adults how to use the techniques of lino cutting in making images for cards using the local woodland and garden for inspiration
